Job Description

- Participate in at-sea and shore-based sampling programs for crustaceans and other species under the direction of the FSRS Research Biologist. The sampling programs will include the completion of scientific data sheets and entering data into a computer based spreadsheet or database.
- Train FSRS members in the collection of scientific data for crustaceans and other species.
- Expand upon the current Lobster Recruitment Index Study to ensure comprehensive geographic coverage, including identifying new participants, training new participants, quality control of data, data entry, and review results with fishermen.
- Review FSRS members' data, provide remedial training as required to ensure high data quality, and enter members' data into a spreadsheet or database.
- Distribute and track distribution of scientific equipment to FSRS members, and maintain equipment.
- Establish a network of fishing industry contacts, including fishermen, fish plant owners and fish plant workers, fishermen's associations, scientists working in fishing or fishery science related disciplines, etc.
- Act as liaison between fishermen and scientists.
- Support efforts to ensure effective communication between fishermen, FSRS staff, scientists, and the general public. This will include participating in the organization and implementation of workshops and local area meetings.
- Other duties as assigned by the Research Biologist, General Manager or Project Leaders.
